Delirium is one of the most common conditions found in general hospitals, and causes poor outcomes for individuals and organisations alike. This congress programme is designed to provide a comprehensive overview of current thinking about delirium, including basic science, epidemiology, assessment, treatment, prevention, research design, and service models that can improve delirium management. There is a mixture of lecture sessions, presentations of research from submitted abstracts and practical workshops with delirium experts sharing their skills and expertise.

The European Delirium Association (EDA) is the first international association to specialise in delirium clinical practice and research. It was formed in 2006 in order to provide an international forum for the exchange of information on research and clinical practice in delirium. EDA members are from many disciplines in research and clinical practice (geriatrics, psychiatry, palliative care, neurology, mental health and general nursing, basic biology, psychology, neuroimaging, etc.)
